



Military and Veterans Nonresident Tuition Exemption Request

Do not use this form if the active member of the military is not stationed in CA on active duty, and, the military member's home of record is not CA but their domicile or legal residence on military records is CA. Instead, please submit a Residency Reclassification Request form and provide proof of the military member's domicile.

Please check one and answer based on your status as of the first day of the semester:

- 1. I am an active member of the military stationed in CA:
