(This new category is **effective Fall 2017** and forward. The 3 year enrollment limitation and the requirement of the service member having to have served at least 90 days or more were deleted for this category effective 7/1/17.)

You may be eligible for **VACA (effective Fall 2015)** (Veterans Access, Choice, and Accountability Act):
